Drinking Water Testing: What You Need to Know

New Hampshire Dept. of Environmental Services recommends testing drinking water wells for the following contaminants every 3-5 years.

Our Standard Drinking Water Test package includes:

Metals: Arsenic, Iron, Lead, Copper,
Manganese, and Sodium

Anions: Chloride, Nitrate, Nitrite,
and Flouride

Bacteria*, **pH****, and **Hardness**

*Bacteria samples can be submitted Mon-Thurs only,
and need to be analyzed within 6 hours of collection.

** pH is an immediate test and needs to be analyzed ASAP

New Hampshire Dept. of Environmental Services recommends testing drinking water wells for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) every 5-10 years.

This includes: MtBE, Benzene, Toluene, Ethyl benzene,
and Xylenes

Additional literature discussing these tests is available at the lab and on our website.

Pick up your drinking water test kit at our facility in Portsmouth, NH Monday- Friday 8:00am-5:00pm at no charge. The test kit will include sample containers, sample chain of custody, sampling instructions, safety information and gloves. You can submit samples Monday- Friday* by dropping off the water samples at the lab. Samples should be submitted the same day they are taken. If you have any questions please call Monday-Thursday 8:00-4:00 and ask for Jen.

*Bacteria samples cannot be submitted on a Friday
